
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1. Mobile Phone Requirements

The BEA Securities Services Mobile App (the Mobile App) is compatible with Apple OS 10 to 14 devices or Android phones equipped with version 6.0 to 9.0 of Android. However, it is not compatible with rooted Android or jail-broken iOS devices.

2. Applying for the Mobile App Service (the Service)

Existing clients of East Asia Securities Company Limited (EAS) can apply for the Service at the EAS Head Office in person or apply online by going to the EAS website and logging in to Cybertrading (Figure 2.1).

3.1 Installing/Re-installing the App

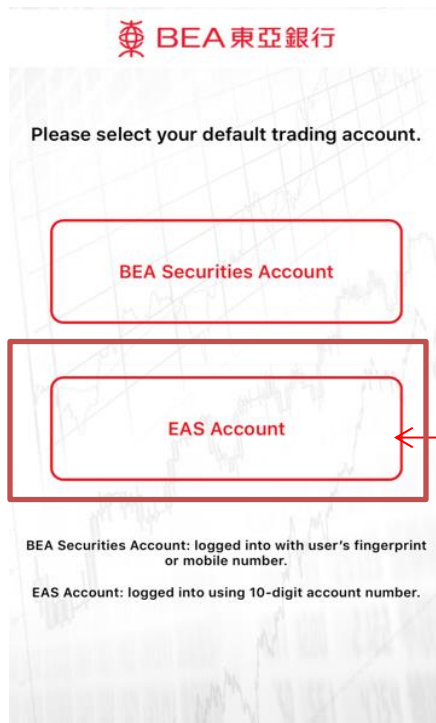


Figure 3.1.1 Entity Selection Page

A "one-time" entity selection page (Figure 3.1.1) will pop up for you to select your default trading account (BEA or EAS) when you first install/re-install the app.

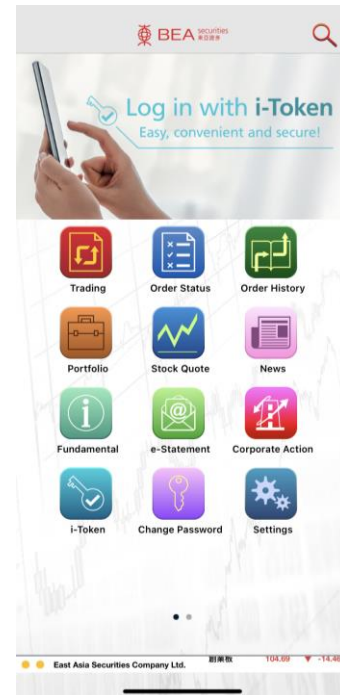


Figure 3.1.2 Home Page

Please select "EAS Account" (Figure 3.1.1), our home page (Figure 3.1.2) will be displayed.

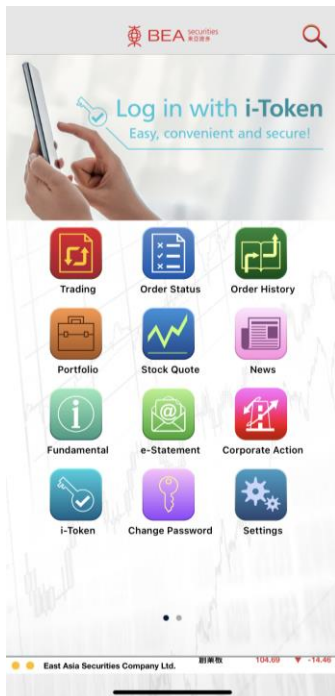
3.2 Logging in Subsequently

The entity selection page will not pop up again. From now on, the home page (Figure 4.1.1) will be displayed when you open the app.

Reminder: The screen capture in this manual is based on the iPhone 6 Plus. The actual screen you see may vary from one device to another. As the performance will depend on the individual mobile phone specifications and network condition, you may refresh the page, reconnect to the mobile network, or close other background apps if the page cannot be displayed or performance is slow.

4. Logging In

4.1 Click “Trading/Order Status/Order History/Portfolio” (Figure 4.1.1) to access the following login page (Figure 4.1.2).

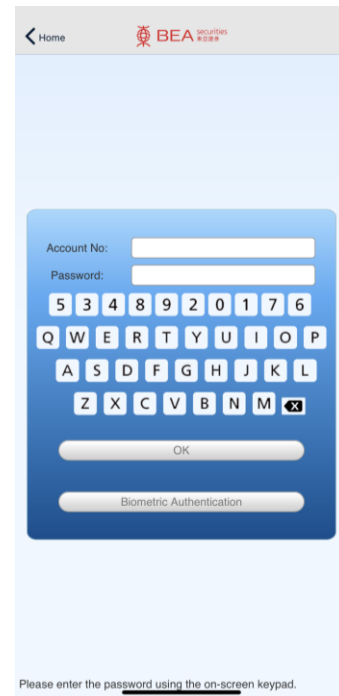




4.2 Enter your account number (digits only) and password using the on-screen keypad and click “OK”.

4.3 You are required to change your password before you log in for the first time (Figure 4.3.1).

1. Existing password: Enter the initial password you receive by SMS or mail in the "Existing Password" field.
2. New password: Enter a new password with **8 to 12 alphanumeric characters.**
3. Confirm password: Enter your new password again.
4. Click "OK".



- 4.4 Enter a “One-time Password” (OTP) and click “Log in” (Figure 4.4.1). Customers are required to activate two-factor authentication (2FA) through the Cybertrading platform. This enables them to access Cybertrading and mobile app services by receiving an SMS-based OTP sent to their registered mobile phone numbers. For details on 2FA activation, please refer to the “Cybertrading Internet Service User Guide”.

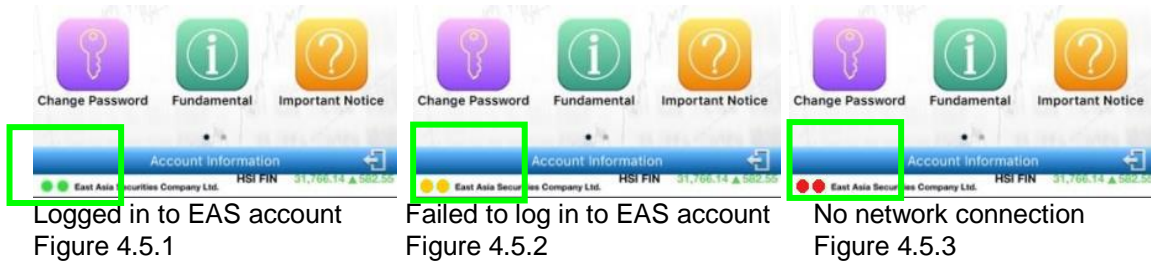

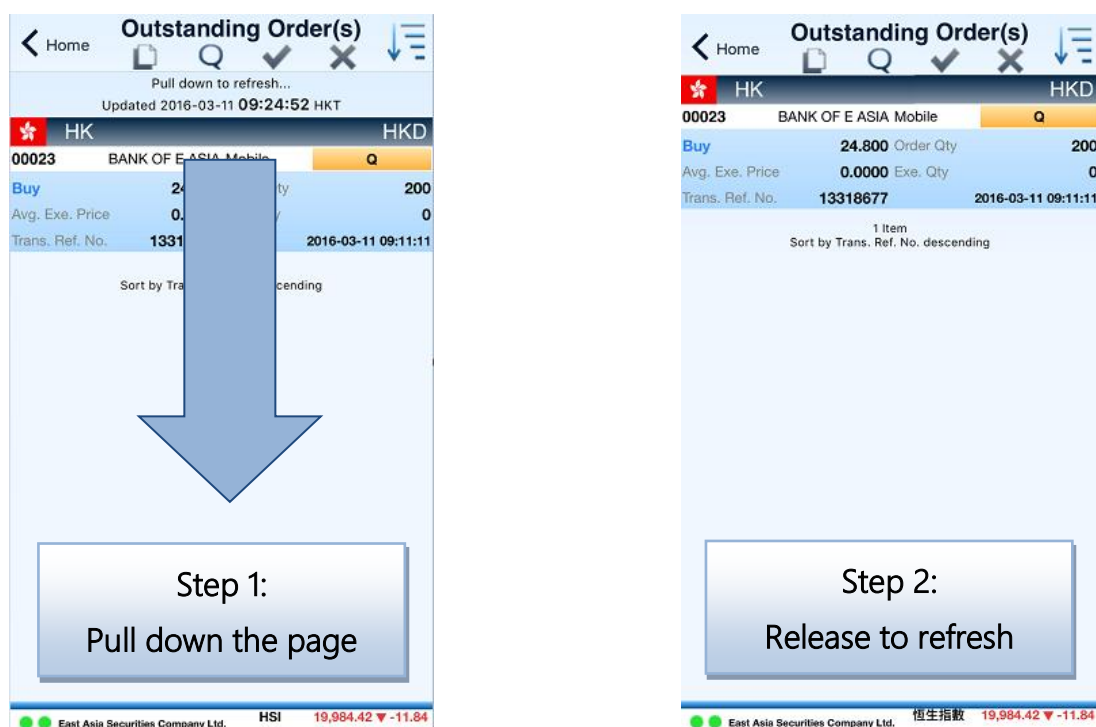

Remaining quote → Display the remaining quote for Per Quote Access service and indicate whether the quote is free of charge or chargeable. During non-trading hours, a delayed quote will be shown.

Swipe to “Chart” and “News” page → Queue page is available during trading hours. During the lunch period and non-trading hours, the “Chart” and “News” pages will be shown.

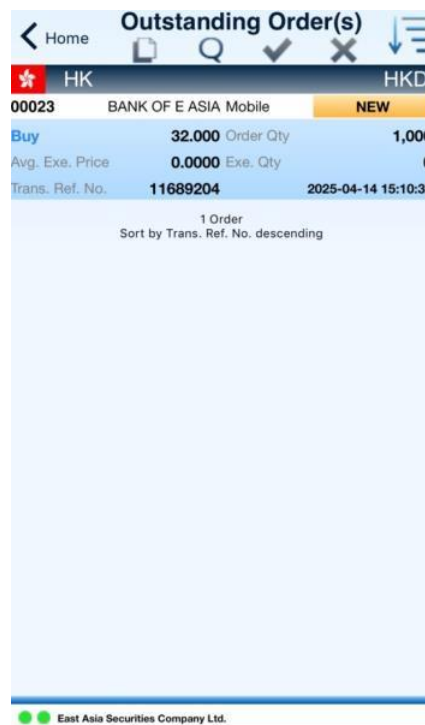

7.1 Amending an Order

You can amend an order in the Order Status page as follows:

Step 1: Swipe left or right (Figure 7.1.1), then press “Amend” (Figure 7.1.2).

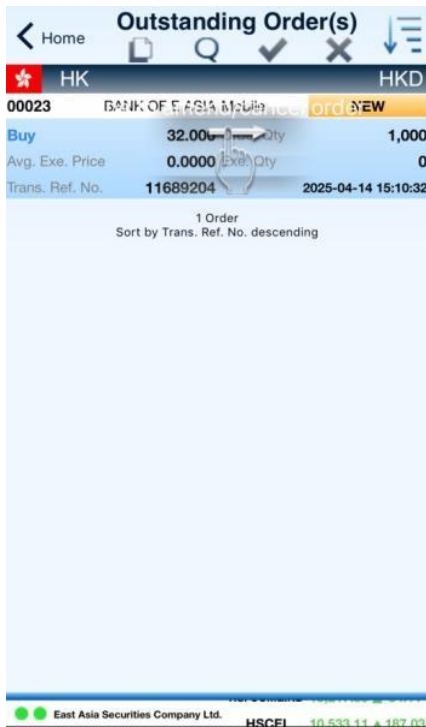

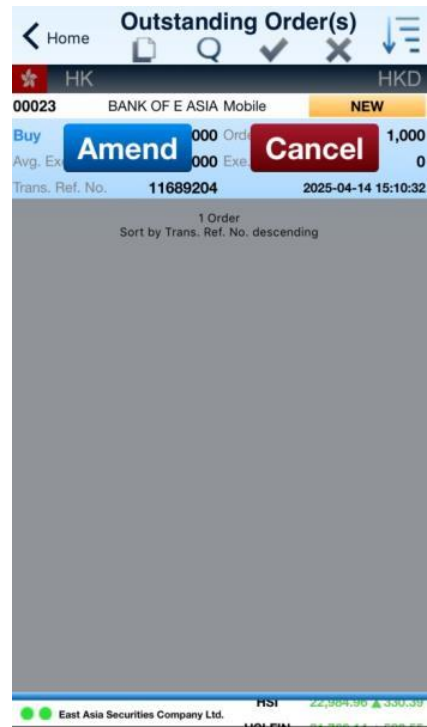

Step 3: Check the order details and press “Confirm” to confirm any changes or “Back” to keep the order unchanged (Figure 7.1.4).

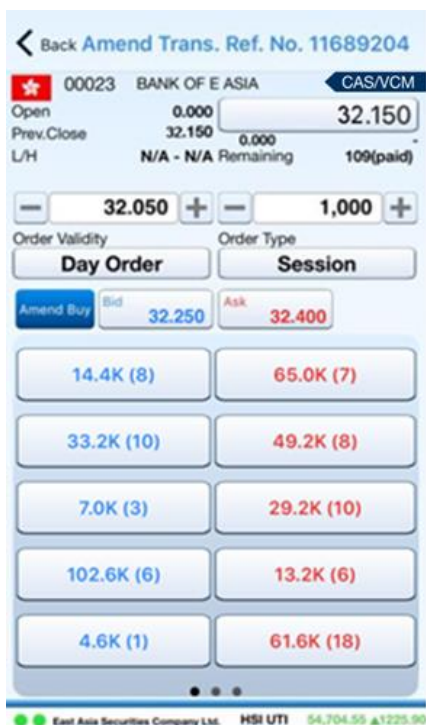

7.2 Cancelling an Order

You can cancel an order in the Order Status page as follows:

Step 1: Swipe left or right across your order (Figure 7.2.1) and press "Cancel".

Step 2: Press "Confirm" to cancel the order (Figure 7.2.2) or "Back" to undo and return to the Order Status page.

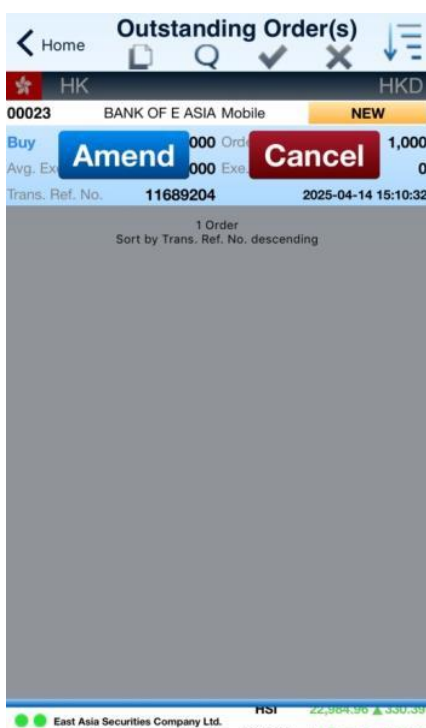

8. Order History



You can view your transaction records, including executed or unexecuted orders in "Order History". You can choose a view of 10, 20, or 30 calendar days, and can sort the orders by stock code or in chronological order (Figure 8.1).

Sorting button ← Press here to sort your orders. Your orders will be sorted as below:

Stock/date filter
This will sort orders for you in ascending order by stock or by date.

Day filter
This allows you to choose how many days of order history to view. You can choose to view 10, 20, or 30 days.

Order record
Check your order information in the order records (i.e. Buy/Sell, stock code, stock name, order price, order quantity, average executed price, executed quantity, transaction reference number, date, and latest updated time).

Stock/date filter set as Stock:
Sorting turned on: sorts by buy/sell, then by time in descending order.
Sorting turned off: sorts by time in descending order, then by buy/sell.

Stock/date filter set as Date:
Sorting turned on: sorts by buy/sell, then by stock code.
Sorting turned off: sorts by stock code, then by buy/sell.



You can check your Hong Kong stock holdings with EAS and trade them directly by pressing the trading button  on the left of the stock code/name (Figure 9.1).





If you have not subscribed to any RTQ service, delayed quotes will be shown on this page.

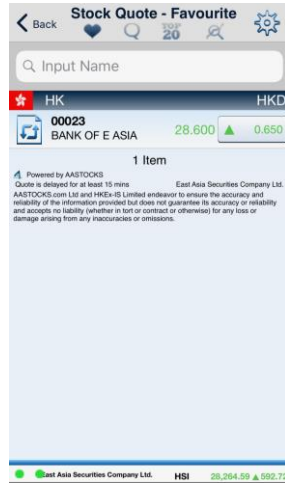


Figure 10.1.1

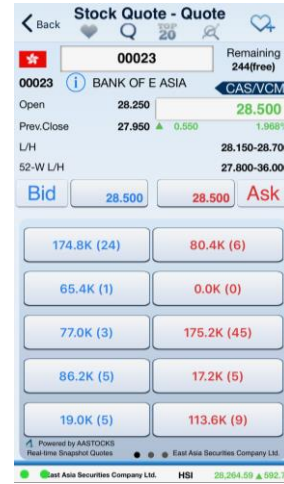


Figure 10.1.2

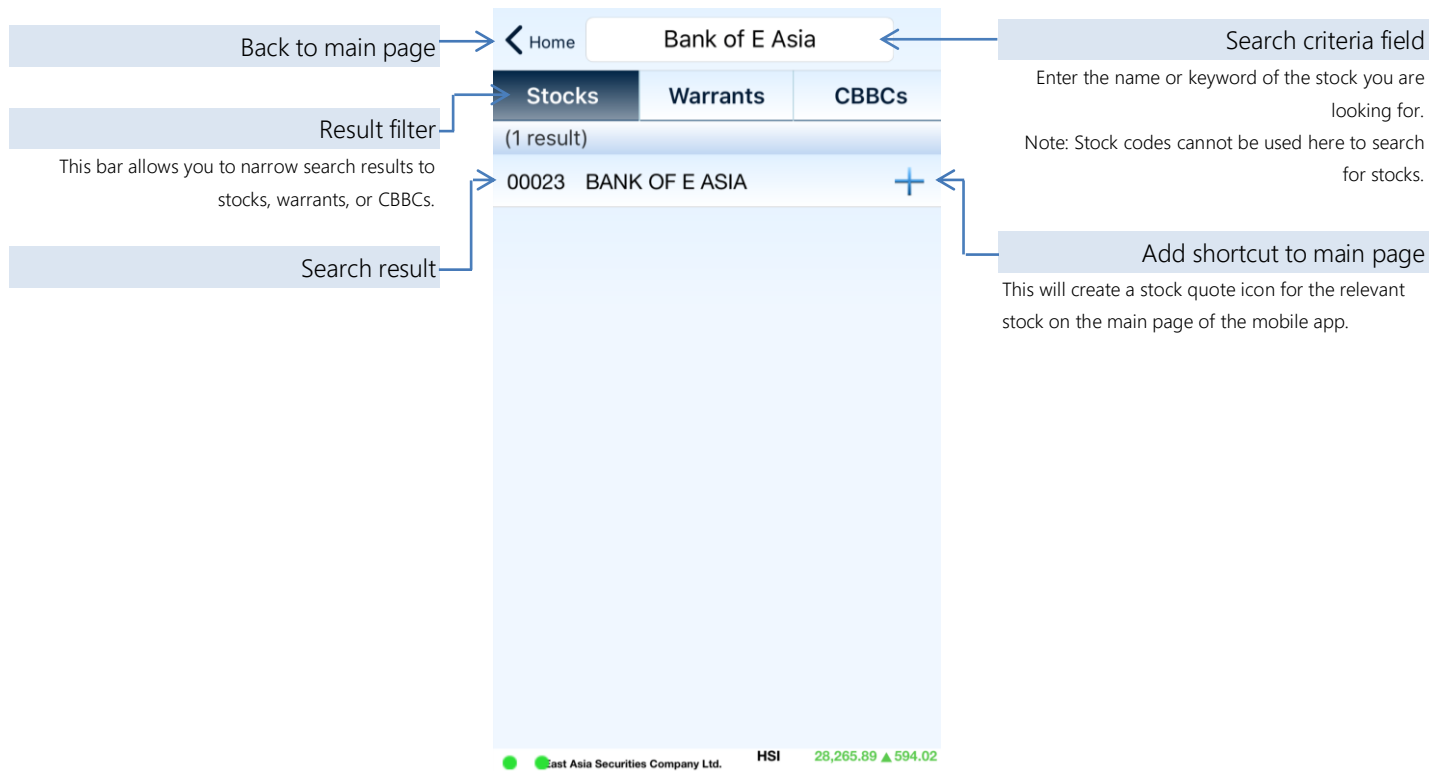

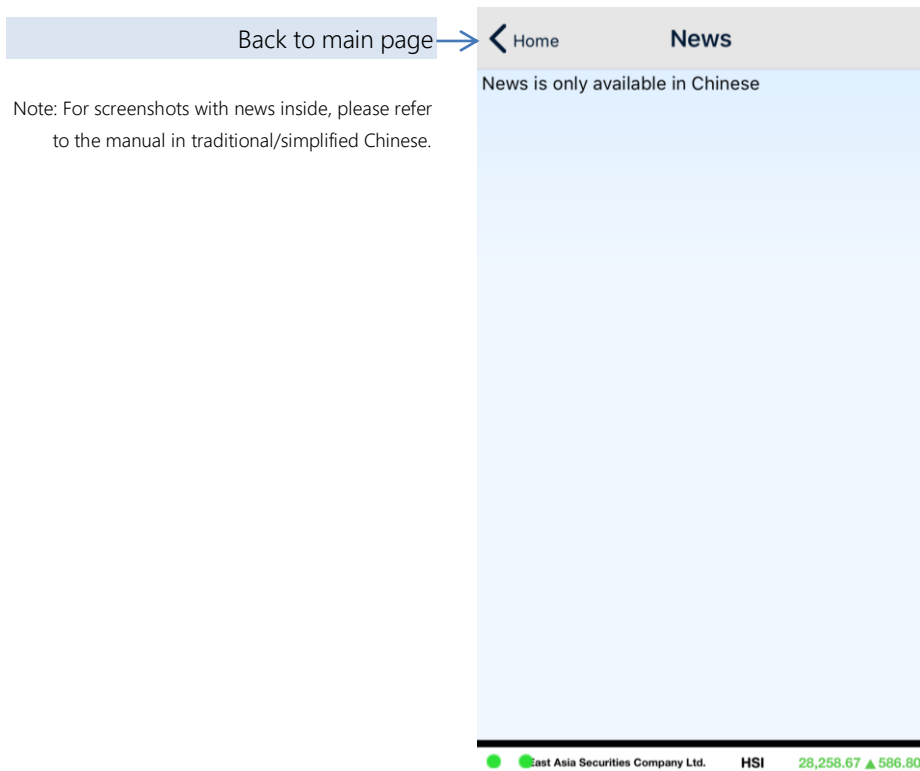
Figure 10.3.2



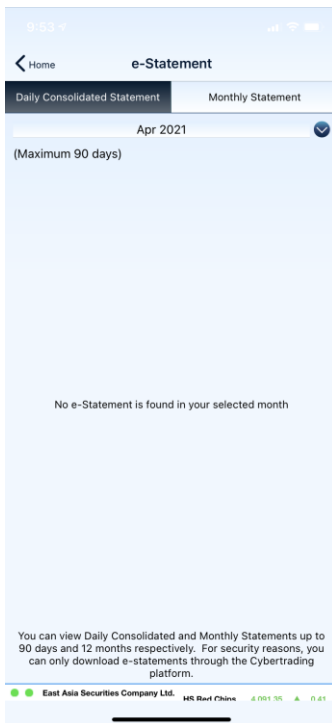

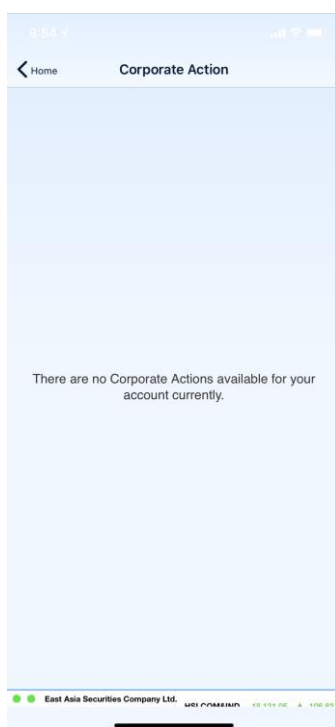

15. i-Token



EAS i-Token (“i-Token”) is a feature of the EAS Mobile Trading App (the “App”) to be used as a fulfillment of the 2-factor authentication (“2FA”) login requirement for better security, and serves an alternative to the current One-Time Password (“OTP”) method.

Remark: Due to security reasons, a device with a registered i-Token can only be bound to one account.

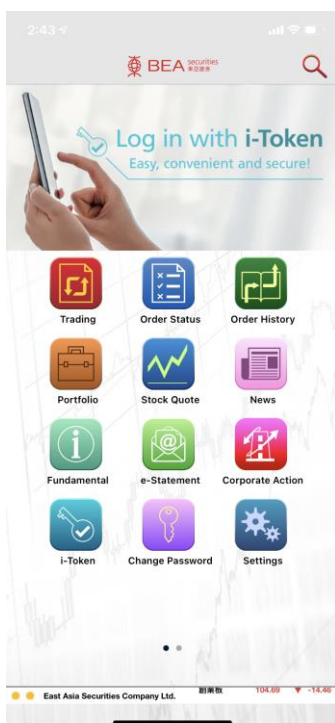

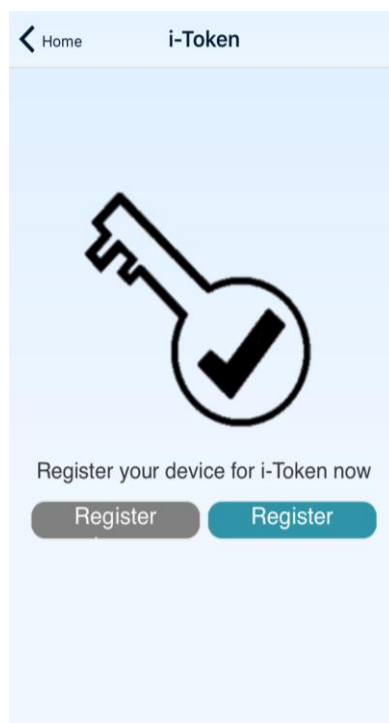

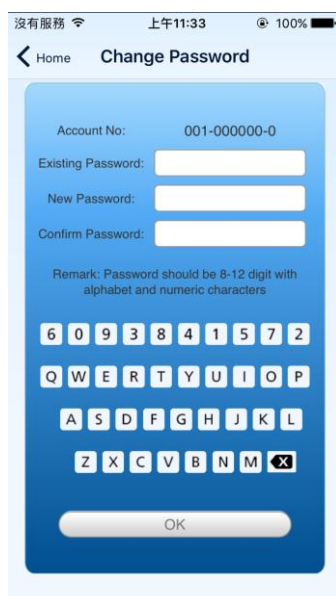

2. Do I need to register my mobile device?

Yes, your mobile device must be registered before you can use the App on it. Press "Device Registration" on the Login screen and enter your account number and registered mobile number to register, then activate your mobile device through our internet trading system or our enquiry hotline on [\(852\) 3608 8021](tel:85236088021). 1. What is Two-factor Authentication?

Two-factor Authentication is a means of identification to enhance the security level of online securities services. It requires customers to provide two kinds of information of different natures for identification. After activating Two-factor Authentication, a "One-time Password" (OTP) will be sent by SMS to your registered mobile phone number. All you need to do is to enter the OTP after entering your Account Number and Personal Identification Number (PIN) to access our online securities services. Every OTP can only be used once and will expire within a short time.

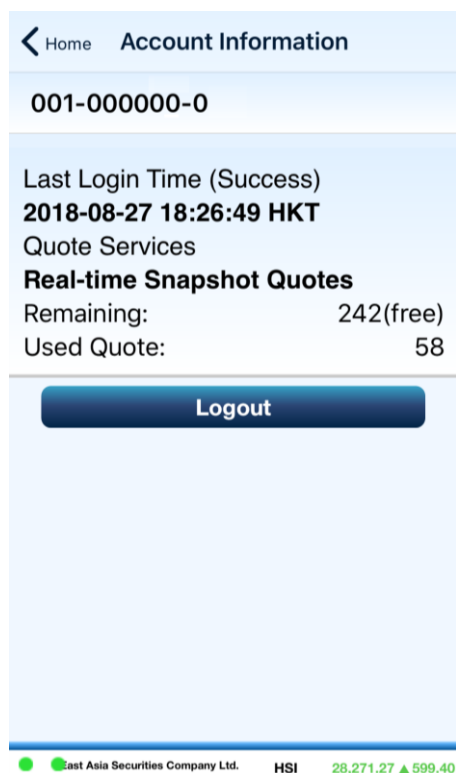

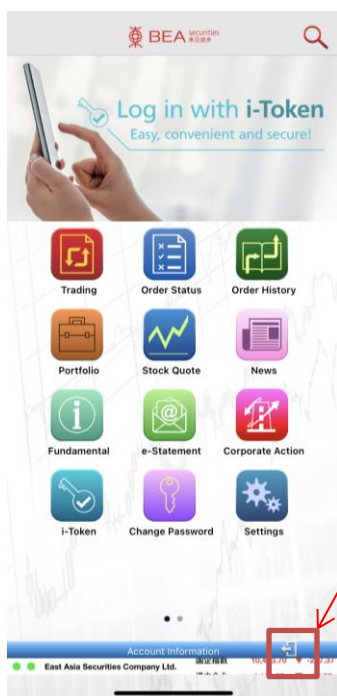
